

The Problem

Valeo technical receive a number of calls asking what are the differences between central slave cylinders (CSC), 830017 and 830018 when supplying a clutch for a Mercedes Atego, kit 827259 (a supersession of 805294)

CSC's 830017 and 830018 have easily recognisable differences. 830017 has a height sensor fitted to the unit. The height sensor is for vehicles fitted with a robotised (semi automatic so no clutch pedal) gearbox.

Below are pictures of the two CSC's with the differences between them arrowed.

Clutch kit 827259 (previously 805294) DOES NOT contain the CSC. The contents of the kit are a clutch cover plate, clutch friction plate and a spigot bearing.
